Directions to Tiffin University Athletic Facilities

Frost-Kalnow Stadium

From Toledo: East on Ohio Turnpike to Exit 6. Follow signs for route 53 South. Proceed south on Route 53 for 22 miles. Follow 53 into Tiffin until it crosses State Route 18. Turn left on 18 and follow to South Monroe St. Turn right on South Monroe and watch for school on right. Stadium is behind school.

From Cleveland: West on Ohio Turnpike to Exit 6. Reach 53 South and follow above directions.

From Canton/Akron: 224 West until you reach Route 53. Turn right on 53 and follow until 53 intersects with State Route 18. Turn right on 18 and follow to South Monroe St. Turn right on South Monroe and watch for school on right. Stadium is behind school.

From Dayton/Cincinnati: 75 North to second Findlay exit, Route 12. Follow Route 12 East to 224 East. You will continue on 224 for about 23 miles into Tiffin. When you get to Tiffin, 224 turns off to the right and Route 18 goes straight. Go straight on Route 18. Follow through Route 53 intersection and watch for South Monroe St. Turn right on South Monroe and watch for school on right. Stadium is behind school.

Outdoor Athletic Events at Tiffin University Athletic Fields

From Toledo: East on Ohio Turnpike to Exit 6. Follow signs for route 53 South. Proceed south on Route 53 for 22 miles. Follow 53 into Tiffin and turn right on Miami St. at school. Follow 1.5 miles and watch for fields on right.

From Cleveland: West on Ohio Turnpike to Exit 6. Reach 53 South and follow above directions.

From Canton/Akron: 224 West until you reach Route 53. Turn right on 53 and follow until school appears on left. Turn left at Miami St. and follow 1.5 miles. Fields will appear on right.

From Dayton/Cincinnati: 75 North to second Findlay exit, Route 12. Follow Route 12 East to 224 East. You will continue on 224 for about 23 miles into Tiffin. When you get to Tiffin, 224 turns off to the right and Route 18 goes straight. Go straight on Route 18. Follow up to Route 53 intersection and turn left on 53. Proceed until school appears on left. Turn left on Miami St. and follow 1.5 miles to fields. Fields will appear on right.

Gillmor Student Center

From Toledo: East on Ohio Turnpike to Exit 6. Follow signs for route 53 South. Proceed south on Route 53 for 22 miles. Follow 53 into Tiffin and turn right on Miami St. at school. Gillmor Center is on right.

From Cleveland: West on Ohio Turnpike to Exit 6. Reach 53 South and follow above directions.

From Canton/Akron: 224 West until you reach Route 53. Turn right on 53 and follow until school appears on left. Turn left at Miami St. and watch for Gillmor Center on right.

From Dayton/Cincinnati: 75 North to second Findlay exit, Route 12. Follow Route 12 East to 224 East. You will continue on 224 for about 23 miles into Tiffin. When you get to Tiffin, 224 turns off to the right and Route 18 goes straight. Go straight on Route 18. Follow up to Route 53 intersection and turn left on 53. Proceed until school appears on left. Turn left on Miami St. and watch for Gillmor Center on right.

MEDIA SERVICES-The Tiffin University sports information office will be available throughout the season to accommodate any media requests. Following are some guidelines that should make it easy for media members to cover the TU athletic teams. Any additional questions should be directed to Shane O'Donnell.

CREDENTIALS-Request for credentials should be made to: Shane O'Donnell, 155 Miami St., Tiffin, OH 44883, or email to sodonnell@tiffin.edu. Request should be made at least 48 hours prior to the day of the game. All credentials are intended for working media only and are not transferable.

GAME SERVICES-The sports information staff will be at your service throughout the game. All media will be provided with game program, rosters, press guides and other pertinent information. Computer generated statistics will be available at halftime and at the conclusion of the game. Information provided includes play-by-play, individual and team statistics. A fax machine is available through the sports information office and media room.

PRESS BOX-The press box is located on the east side of the stadium. Members of the media should enter the north end of Frost Kalnow Stadium. The press box will open two hours before the game.

PHONE LINES-Multiple phone lines are available in the press box on a first-come, first-serve basis and must be given a weeks notice. Permission to broadcast and any arrangements regarding reciprocal lines must first be secured from the sports information office.

PRESS BOX PHONE-The press box phone number at Frost Kalnow Stadium is 419-447-0971.

TELEVISION TRUCKS-Any television crews wishing to do live shots from Frost Kalnow Stadium must coordinate parking arrangements with the sports information office prior to the game.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE-Food and beverages will be available to the media in the press box prior to the game and half-time for media and working press box staff.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Admission

Admission to basketball and football games is \$8.00/adults and \$5.00/students.

Athletic Training

Athletic training staff is available to assist your team with all of its training needs. A certified athletic trainer will be present before, during, and after each contest. We provide water and ice on sidelines. Please notify our training staff prior to the day of contest if you will be traveling without a certified trainer.

Locker Rooms

Locker room facilities are available at most athletic events. Visiting teams need to bring their own towels and locks. The locker room will be secure during contests.

Sports Information

Our sports information office will provide visiting teams complete game statistics upon request. Final scores will be reported to local media outlets. Numerical rosters, updated statistics and game programs will be provided for all requested sports as available. Radio broadcasts can occur from Frost Kalnow Stadium and the Gillmor Center. Requests for radio or television broadcasts must be approved through the sports information office the week before the contest. Please call with any special requests a minimum of one day prior to your event.

SPORTS SPECIFICS

Baseball: Games are played at Heminger Field at the Paradiso Athletic Complex. Visitors use the firstbase dugout. Parking is available next to the field.

Basketball: Games are played in the Gillmor Center. Visiting team bench is located on the south side of the scorer's table towards the south end of the gym. Locker rooms are in the gym. Team busses or vans park in the receiving entrance of the campus next to the Gillmor Center. Visiting teams wear dark uniforms.

Football: Games are played at Frost Kalnow Stadium. Visitor bench is located on the west side of the field and warm up is at the south end of the field. Teams come to the stadium to dress. Visiting teams wear white uniforms.

Soccer: Games are played at the soccer fields at the Paradiso Athletic Complex. Team bench is located north of the scorer's table toward the north goal. Pregame warm up is on the north end of Bremer Field. Locker rooms are located in the Athletic Fieldhouse. Visiting teams wear dark uniforms.

Softball: Games are played at the softball fields at the Paradiso Athletic Complex. Parking is available adjacent to the field. Team bench is on the first base side.

Tennis: Matches are played at the Tiffin University Tennis Courts next to the Physical Fitness Center. Parking is located next to courts.

Track & Field: Outdoor meets are held at Frost Kalnow Stadium. Parking is available at the stadium.

Volleyball: Games are played in the Gillmor Center. Locker rooms are located in the gym. Team busses or vans can park in the Receiving Entrance next to the Gillmor Center if space allows.
